

THE HENRY CLIFTON SORBY AWARD:

The Sorby Award was established to recognize outstanding contributions to the field of metallography. No more than one individual shall be selected to receive this award each year. An award need not be presented every year. The person selected for this award must:

- 1. Be living.
- 2. Be over 55 years of age.
- 3. Have devoted more than 25 years to the general field of metallography.
- 4. Be considered an international figure in the field of metallography.

The person selected need not be a member of IMS. The recipient must be approved by the Board of Directors of IMS. The award is a plaque and coverage of all travel and expenses paid to the IMS Annual Convention.
